

## DIRECTIONS TO CAMP IDYLLWILD

We are happy to have visitors! Just email or call in advance. If you are planning to pick your child up from camp, please let us know in advance and arrive before 3:45pm. There are three general ways to get to camp – you can pick the route below that suits you best. **However, just a warning - we strongly recommend avoiding using GPS systems...**you will probably end up on a dirt road somewhere in Duck River...(sometimes they work, sometimes they don't). Depending on which route you take, it will take somewhere between 1 and 1.5 hours to get to camp.

### Option 1: Natchez Trace Parkway

Enter Natchez Trace Parkway at the closest entry point to you (either at Hwy 100 in Nashville, Hwy 96 in Franklin or Hwy 46 in Leipers Fork). Head south toward Mississippi on Natchez Trace Parkway and drive until you get to the Hwy 50 exit (21 miles from the Hwy 46 entry near mile marker 408). Exit the Parkway and turn RIGHT onto Hwy 50 (heading west toward Centerville). Drive about 10 1/2 miles and turn LEFT onto Blue Buck Road.

### Option 2: HWY 100

Take Hwy 100 southwest until you get to Hwy 230 (around 30 miles from the Warner park area) and turn LEFT onto Hwy 230 (there will be a triangular sign with "230" on it on the right side of the road just before you get to the Hwy 230 turn) and drive about 9 1/2 miles to the end of 230 and turn RIGHT onto Hwy 50, heading west toward Centerville. Drive west on Hwy 50 for about 5 1/2 miles and turn LEFT onto Blue Buck Road.

### Option 3: I-40

Take I-40 west to Exit 172 (Dickson/Centerville). At the off-ramp stoplight turn LEFT onto Hwy 46 (Centerville). Drive approx. 6 - 7 miles and then turn RIGHT onto Hwy 100. Drive another 6 - 7 miles until you get to Hwy 230. Turn LEFT onto Hwy 230 (look for the triangular sign with "230" on it on the right side of the road). Drive 9 1/2 miles to the end of Hwy 230 and turn RIGHT onto Hwy 50, heading west toward Centerville. Drive west on Hwy 50 for about 5 1/2 miles and turn LEFT onto Blue Buck Road.

Blue Buck Road will be off Hwy 50, just opposite a long brick faced building on the right side of the road. Turn LEFT onto Blue Buck Road (when heading west on Hwy 50). Drive 2.5 miles to the end of this road and then turn LEFT at the end - this will be Blue Buck Creek Road. Camp will be on the right hand side of the road, and the entrance is just past the wood fence. Turn RIGHT into the first driveway and park anywhere in the gravel before you get to the bridge.
